FIRST READING - Isaiah 49.3, 5-6

A reading from the book of prophet Isaiah.

The Lord said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified." And now the Lord says, who formed me in the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him, for I am honoured in the sight of the Lord, and my God has become my strength. He says, "It is too small a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the survivors of Israel; I will give you as a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

RESPONSORIAL PSALM - Psalm 40.1+3a, 6, 7-8, 9 (R.7-8)

R. Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.

I waited patiently for the Lord; he inclined to me and heard my cry. He put a new song in my mouth, song of praise to our God. **R.**

Sacrifice and offering you do not desire, but you have given me an open ear. Burnt offering and sin offering you have not required. **R.**

Then I said, "He re I am; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. I delight to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart." **R.**

I have told the glad news of deliverance in the great congregation; see, I have not restrained my lips, as you know, O Lord. **R.**

SECOND READING - 1 Corinthians 1.1-3

A reading from the first letter of Paul to the Corinthians.

From Paul, called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and from our brother Sosthenes. To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, together with all those who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

GOSPEL - John 1.29-34

A reading from the holy gospel according to John.

John the Baptist saw Jesus coming toward him and declared, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me.' I myself did not know him; but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel." And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God."

NOTIZIE ITALIANE - Domenica 18 Gennaio 2026

Dal Vangelo secondo Giovanni - Gv 1,29-34

In quel tempo, Giovanni, vedendo Gesù venire verso di lui, disse: «Ecco l'agnello di Dio, colui che toglie il peccato del mondo! Egli è colui del quale ho detto: "Dopo di me viene un uomo che è avanti a me, perché era prima di me". Io non lo conoscevo, ma sono venuto a battezzare nell'acqua, perché egli fosse manifestato a Israele». Giovanni testimoniò dicendo: «Ho contemplato lo Spirito discendere come una colomba dal cielo e rimanere su di lui. Io non lo conoscevo, ma proprio colui che mi ha inviato a battezzare nell'acqua mi disse: "Colui sul quale vedrai discendere e rimanere lo Spirito, è lui che battezza nello Spirito Santo". E io ho visto e ho testimoniato che questi è il Figlio di Dio». **Parola di Dio.**

Giovanni ha visto qualcosa di sconvolgente, cioè il Figlio amato di Dio solidale con i peccatori; e lo Spirito Santo gli ha fatto comprendere la novità inaudita, un vero ribaltamento. Infatti, mentre in tutte le religioni è l'uomo che offre e sacrifica qualcosa a Dio, nell'evento Gesù è Dio che offre il proprio Figlio per la salvezza dell'umanità. Giovanni manifesta il suo stupore e il suo consenso a questa novità portata da Gesù, mediante un'espressione pregnante che noi ripetiamo ogni volta nella Messa: «Ecco l'agnello di Dio, colui che toglie il peccato del mondo!». La testimonianza di Giovanni Battista ci invita a ripartire sempre di nuovo nel nostro cammino di fede: ripartire da Gesù Cristo, Agnello pieno di misericordia che il Padre ha dato per noi. Lasciarci nuovamente sorprendere dalla scelta di Dio di stare dalla nostra parte, di farsi solidale con noi peccatori, e di salvare il mondo dal male facendosene carico totalmente. Impariamo da Giovanni Battista a non presumere di conoscere già Gesù, di sapere già tutto di Lui. Non è così. Fermiamoci sul Vangelo, magari anche contemplando un'icona di Cristo, un "Volto santo". Contempliamo con gli occhi e più ancora col cuore; e lasciamoci istruire dallo Spirito Santo, che dentro ci dice: È Lui!
